

100mw solar power plant Seychelles

Once completed, Seychelles will have built the world's largest salt-water floating solar plant. The project, which has been seven years in the making, will see the installation of a 5-megawatt photovoltaic system in the lagoon at Providence, on the eastern coast of Mahe, which will help Seychelles move closer to its zero-emissions target.
