How much energy does a wind turbine produce a year?

On average, there are about 50 wind turbines per farm, and typically, one of these turbines can produce 6 million kWh per year. That would mean that one wind farm could produce 300,000 MW a year. What is a wind turbine & how does it work?

A wind turbine is a device that converts the kinetic energy of wind into electrical energy. As of 2020, hundreds of thousands of large turbines, in installations known as wind farms, were generating over 650 gigawatts of power, with 60 GW added each year.

How much power does a wind turbine generate per rotation?

For example, assuming a mean wind velocity of 12 m/s, a 2 MW usual wind turbine will produce significant power, with each rotation generating significant amounts of that power. However, the power generated per rotation is significantly dependent on the size of the turbine and the speed at which the wind is moving.

Why do wind turbines produce more energy?

Obviously, faster winds help too: if the wind blows twice as quickly, there's potentially eight times more energy available for a turbine to harvest. That's because the energy in wind is proportional to the cube of its speed. Wind varies all the time so the electricity produced by a single wind turbine varies as well.

How many kWh can a wind turbine power a day?

Just 26 kWh of energy can power an entire home for a day. Wind is the third largest source of electricity in the United States with 40 of the 50 states having at least one wind farm. That explains why wind turbine service technician is one of the fastest-growing jobs in the United States.
