Where should solar panels be installed?

To maximise the output of solar panels, you will want to have them installed on a south-facing section of your roof. South-facing solar panels in the UK receive the most sunlight exposure, as the sun is in the sky the most in this direction.

Which direction should solar panels face?

South is the best direction for solar panels to face overall. In nearly all situations, you will see the greatest utility bill savings and quickest payback period if your panels point south instead of in another direction. South-facing panels have superior economics for the following reasons: They allow for better solar battery utilization.

Can solar panels be installed on a roof?

Although it's common to see solar panels on roofs, they can also be installed in gardens and on walls, as we'll explore below. When it comes to solar installation in your garden, the best angle and orientation are very similar to rooftop installation - ranging from about 30 to 40°.

What angle should solar panels be installed on a flat roof?

The best angle for a solar panel system in the UK is between 20° and 50°. At this kind of angle, your solar panels will be exposed to more sunlight, which will lead to more energy production and larger savings. If you want to install solar panels on a flat roof, you can still achieve the optimal angle by propping them onto a mounting system.

Which direction should solar panels be mounted?

The best direction is to have your panels facing south, followed by west or east. You can position/optimize your panels on a flat roof using a mounting system. How to choose a solar installation angle?

If connected to a stand-alone power system, the installation angle of solar panels should be based on the light conditions to obtain the maximum power output. Generally, if the output of the solar panels can be met even on the lowest light intensity of the year, then the solar output at the chosen angle will meet the year-round demand.
