

Is Azerbaijan a 'crucial Energy partner' for the EU?

Speaking to reporters in Baku this morning, von der Leyen described Azerbaijan as a "crucial energy partner" for the EU and noted the urgency for the bloc "to diversify away from Russia and to turn to more reliable, trustworthy suppliers."

Why did Azerbaijan sign a new energy agreement?

The document was signed by Azerbaijan's President Ilham Aliyev and European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen as part of the latter's visit to Baku. While addressing a joint press briefing, President Aliyev explained the newly signed document came as a result of the 15-year-long active energy cooperation between the sides.

How will ACWA Power Save Energy in Azerbaijan?

The plant will save about 220 million cubic metres of natural gas and reduce carbon emissions by more than 400,000 tonnes per year upon completion. ACWA Power entered the Azerbaijan market in 2019 and continues to expand its geographic footprint in the country.
