The Comoros,[note 1]officially the Union of the Comoros,[note 2]is an archipelagic country made up of three islands in Southeastern Africa,located at the northern end of the Mozambique Channel in the Indian Ocean. Its capital and largest city is Moroni.

What is the religion of Comoros?

Its capital and largest city is Moroni. The religion of the majority of the population,and the official state religion,is Sunni Islam. Comoros proclaimed its independence from France on 6 July 1975. The Comoros is the only country of the Arab League which is entirely in the Southern Hemisphere.

Is Comoros a member of the World Bank?

The Comoros is a member of the United Nations,the African Union,the Arab League,the World Bank,the International Monetary Fund,the Indian Ocean Commission and the African Development Bank. On 10 April 2008,the Comoros became the 179th nation to accept the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

Is Comoros a Muslim country?

Sunni Islam is the dominant religion,followed by as much as 99% of the population. Comoros is the only Muslim-majority country in Southern Africaand one of the three southernmost Muslim-majority territories,along with Mayotte and the Australian territory of Cocos Islands.

How many people live in Comoros?

With about 850,000residents,the Comoros is one of the least populous countries in the world,but its population density is high,with an average of 275 inhabitants per square kilometre (710/sq mi).

Is Comoros part of the Arab League?

The Comoros is the only country of the Arab Leaguewhich is entirely in the Southern Hemisphere. It is a member state of the African Union,the Organisation internationale de la Francophonie,the Organisation of Islamic Co-operation,and the Indian Ocean Commission. The country has three official languages: Shikomori,French and Arabic.
