

Can photovoltaic panels be installed in a floor-slab house

Do you need planning permission to install solar panels on your roof?

An increasing number of people are investing in solar energy. More and more homes are having solar panels, or solar tiles, installed on their roofs. Of course, with such installations, the topic of planning permission and building regulations often comes to the surface.

Can solar panels be mounted on a flat roof?

For solar panels on a flat roof, mounting systems are slightly different and can include a triangle 'ballast' box to support the panels. For solar thermal panels (with cells that use the sun's heat to warm water in a house) things are a little different.

Can solar panels power a wet underfloor heating system?

Wet underfloor heating systems can be powered by solar thermal panels, or you can use solar PV panels to supply the energy for an electric water heater. Solar thermal panels are essentially solar panels that use the sun's energy to heat water, which can be used in radiators, underfloor heating, and bathrooms.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.
