Can solar panels be installed on a fibre cement roof?

Briarwood recommends the use of solar panels installed on any fibre cement roof providing it has been correctly designed and pre-planned prior to installation. There are various types of solar panel systems which can be installed above a fibre cement roofed structure.

When should a solar panel system be used?

Solar panel systems should only be used where the weight of the entire solar panel system is supported by the purlin and/or the building's structure without adding any additional point-loading at any fixing position of the fibre cement roof sheet above the fixing tightness of a standard fibre cement roof.

Can a solar panel be installed on a roof?
