Demographic profile. The Central African Republic's (CAR) humanitarian crisis has worsened since the coup of March 2013. CAR's high mortality rate and low life expectancy are attributed to elevated rates of preventable and treatable diseases (including malaria and malnutrition), an inadequate health care system, precarious food security, and armed conflict.

It will be recalled that the Bank's Boards of Directors approved the Country Strategy Paper (CSP) 2017-2021 for the Central African Republic (CAR) in November 2017. The overall objective of the CSP 2017-2021 was to help the country emerge from its fragile situation and create conditions for strong and inclusive economic growth.

The Central African Republic mainly consists of Sudano-Guinean savannas, but the country also includes a Sahelo-Sudanian zone in the north and an equatorial forest zone in the south. Two-thirds of the country is within the Ubangi River basin (which flows into the Congo), while the remaining third lies in the basin of the Chari, which flows into Lake Chad.
