

Do solar panels need to be registered

How do I register a solar PV system?

If you're planning to install a solar PV system in your home, you must register it with your Distribution Network Operator (DNO). The DNO is the company responsible for bringing electricity to your home. Usually, your installer will register the device for you.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

Do I need a building regulations certificate for my solar panel system?

You should receive a building regulations certificate, known as a completion certificate, for your solar panel system. This certificate will assure you and any future owners that the work met all building regulations, which will make it much easier to sell your property at any point.

Do I need planning permission to install solar panels?

However, make sure you follow all building regulations and apply for planning permission if necessary, as your neighbour could report your installation to the local authority if you don't - which could result in your panels having to come down.

Can I Register my solar system without a Certified Installer?

Here's a straightforward guide for homeowners. The great news is that DIYers can also register their system without depending on certified installers. The type of application depends on your solar system's capacity: G98 Application: This is for smaller systems that produce up to 3.68 kW per phase (equivalent to 16A).

Do I need to register my energy device?

Apply for relevant energy efficiency schemes. If you are planning to install an energy device in your home or small business, you are required to register your energy device with your Distribution Network Operator (DNO), the company that is responsible for bringing electricity to the property where you are installing the device.
