What is the gap between solar panels & roof?

Talking about the gap between solar panels and the roof, the distance between the last row of solar panels and the edge of the roof should be a minimum of 12 inches. The gap between the last row of solar panels and the roof's edge should be a minimum of 12 inches or one foot. This ensures the panels are accommodated as they expand and contract during the day. Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5.
