Norwegian developer Scatec ASA has signed a 25-year power purchase agreement (PPA) for a 1 GW solar array and 100 MW/200 MWh battery storage project in Egypt. CEO Terje Pilskog says it is Egypt's first hybrid solar-plus-battery project.

Will Egypt build a microgrid?

Earlier this year, state-owned utility Egyptian Electricity Holding Co. held an expressions-of-interest tender for the design, construction and operation of a 8.2 MW solar plant and 2 MW/4MWh battery energy storage system, which would be built at the site of an existing microgrid in western Egypt.

As per news reports, Egypt's Ministry of Electricity and Renewable Energy (MERE) has announced that the country requires long-duration, low-cost electricity storage systems, which will be integrated with renewable energy (RE) plants in a comprehensive power generation system.

The BESS Alliance seeks to expedite the deployment of reliable and efficient renewable energy storage systems, particularly for low and middle-income countries, addressing the rising energy demand and providing electricity access to approximately 3 billion people globally, according to the ministry.

The energy storage arm of Chinese solar PV inverter manufacturer Sungrow announced the signing of an agreement earlier this week with renewable energy company MSR-Green Energy (MSR-GE) for the 100MW/400MWh project in Sabah, a state in northern Borneo.

The alliance aims to enhance joint work to secure 5 GWs of stored energy by 2024, and take a step towards achieving the alliance's goals of achieving 400 GWs of renewable energy to meet the global energy need by 2030, the Ministry of International Cooperation stated.
