Except for hydroelectric generation, which is almost totally owned and operated by the public company CEL (Comisi3n Hidroel3ctrica del R3o Lempa), the rest of the generation capacity is in private hands. With demand expected to grow at a ra...

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El Salvador has prioritised renewable energy projects to reduce its dependence on imported fossil fuels and improve energy security. The National Energy Policy 2010-2024 has become a key tool for the country to advance the use of indigenous renewables, including hydropower, biomass, solar photovoltaic (PV) and geothermal power.

Since adopting the Paris agreement, El Salvador has prioritized clean energy sources and system-wide improvements in energy efficiency. Bioenergy, geothermal, hydropower, solar, wind, and ocean energy are the key renewable sectors receiving funding. [1]
