

Energy storage containers Hong Kong

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) and the Airport Authority Hong Kong (AA) have jointly designed and developed the city's largest battery energy storage system (BESS) along with a predictive control system for air conditioning, using advanced smart technology to enhance the airport's energy efficiency, and form a part of the wider

By combining an energy storage system and an integrated ECO Controller TM --Atlas Copco's Energy Management System (EMS)-- with low-emission modular assets, such as solar and other renewable sources, you can decarbonize your operations, while achieving significant fuel, energy and lifecycle savings.

The system includes a lithium battery energy storage system, energy storage converter, air conditioner, fire protection, and vehicle-mounted box. The energy storage vehicle has a configuration capacity of 576kWh and an output power of 250KW, which can meet the power supply requirement of a 250kW load for 2 hours.

BESS is the first high voltage battery energy storage system in Hong Kong. Throughout the project stages from feasibility study and design to installation, testing and commissioning, the team has made concerted effort to liaise and coordinate with different parties such as power utilities, battery suppliers, experts and contractors.

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Ampd Energy is a Hong Kong start-up with ambitions of eradicating diesel generators and lead acid UPSs; Ampd Silo is the first product launched to provide clean, safe and reliable energy backup storage using lithium-ion batteries

The Airport Authority (AA) and CLP have jointly developed a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) to cope with HKIA's continued growth and need for backup power supply. This is the largest battery storage system in Hong Kong which contains over 400 lithium batteries, equivalent to more than 55,000 pieces of 10,000 mAh portable power banks.

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These energy storage systems come in a 10ft container. Designed to meet the requirements for off- and on-grid applications, they are ideal in combination with renewable stations, providing up to 9,2 MWh of storage capacity -with 16 ZBC 250-575 units connected in parallel.

As a low carbon alternative, Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) has been viewed as a viable option to replace traditional diesel-fuelled construction site equipment.
