What is the French Southern Territories?

The territory is sometimes referred to as the French Southern Lands (French: Terres australes fran&#231;aises) or the French Southern Territories, usually to emphasize non-recognition of French sovereignty over Ad&#233;lie Land as part of the Antarctic Treaty System. The entire territory has no known permanently settled inhabitants.

What are the French Southern & Antarctic Lands?

The French Southern and Antarctic Lands are an overseas territory of France that consist of the following: Ad&#233;lie Land (Terre Ad&#233;lie): This is the French claim on the continent of Antarctica. Crozet Islands (&#206;les Crozet): A group of islands in the southern Indian Ocean, located south of Madagascar.

What is the French Southern Territories nature reserve?

In 2006, the French Southern Territories Nature Reserve was created around the Crozet archipelago and the Kerguelen, Saint-Paul and Amsterdam islands. This reserve, which by 2022 will cover an area of 1.6 million km<sup>2</sup>, is one of the largest marine protected areas in the world and has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2019.

Which islands are part of the French Southern & Antarctic Lands?

The islands, along with Ad&#233;lie Land, the Crozet Islands, Amsterdam and Saint Paul islands, and France's Scattered Islands in the Indian Ocean, are part of the French Southern and Antarctic Lands and are administered as a separate district.
