

How many solar power plants are there in Norway?

In 2023, most of the solar power in Norway is installed on the roofs of households and industry, and primarily cover their own consumption. As of 31 March 2023, there are no dedicated solar power plants in Norway. During 2022, approximately 153 MW of new solar power was installed in Norway.

Are Norwegian solar panels eco-friendly?

The ecological footprint of solar panels made with materials from Norway is therefore extremely small. REC Solar's factory in Fiskå in southwestern Norway has even been awarded a certificate for production of the world's cleanest silicon. Currently, almost 90 % (which corresponds to approximately 7,000 photovoltaic systems) of the total installed solar power in Norway is connected to the Norwegian power grid.
