Does Guernsey have electricity?

The cable connection to France provides most of the electric energy sold in Guernsey, but the power station still needs to maintain sufficient capacity to generate power should the cable fail. There are eight oil-fired diesel engines and three oil-fired gas turbines.

What is the energy strategy for Guernsey?

The Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure is developing an Electricity Strategy for Guernsey. The strategy will consider expected future energy demand levels and set out how this demand could be met, whilst also reviewing how the market structure will need to change to support this.

What is the energy transition in Guernsey?

In Guernsey, we currently rely on fossil-fuel based systems of energy production and consumption and operate a thermal power station. However, it is recognised that as part of the response to climate change, there is a need to transition to an energy mix with limited, if not zero carbon emissions. This is often referred to as the energy transition.

Who is Guernsey Gas Light Company Limited?

The Guernsey Gas Light Company Limited was formed. Gas was used in local homes, proving to be a safe and cost-effective fuel for heating, cooking and hot water. All local gas was generated from coal at production plants in St Peter Port. It was decided to manufacture mains gas from Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) Butane and Propane.
