

What is thermal energy storage?

Thermal energy storage (TES) is a technology that stocks thermal energy by heating or cooling a storage medium so that the stored energy can be used at a later time for heating and cooling applications and power generation. TES systems are used particularly in buildings and in industrial processes.

What is cool thermal energy storage (CTEs)?

Cool thermal energy storage (CTES) has recently attracted interest for its industrial refrigeration applications, such as process cooling, food preservation, and building air-conditioning systems. PCMs and their thermal properties suitable for air-conditioning applications can be found in [76].

What is thermochemical heat storage?

Thermochemical heat storage is a technology under development with potentially high-energy densities. The binding energy of a working pair, for example, a hydrating salt and water, is used for thermal energy storage in different variants (liquid/solid, open/closed) with strong technological links to adsorption and absorption chillers.

What are the applications of thermochemical energy storage?

Numerous researchers published reviews and research studies on particular applications, including thermochemical energy storage for high temperature source and power generation [1, 2, 3], battery thermal management, textiles [31, 32], food, buildings [4, 5, 6], heating systems and solar power plants.

Why is thermal energy storage a key cross-sectional technology?

Thermal energy storage (TES) systems correct this mismatch between the supply and demand of the thermal energy. Hence, TES is a key cross-sectional technology with growing present and future importance for utilizing volatile renewable sources (e.g., wind and photovoltaics) and energy efficiency improvements.

Which components are developed for latent thermal energy storage systems?

Furthermore, components for latent thermal energy storage systems are developed including macroencapsulated PCM and immersed heat exchanger configurations. For material development the following key points can be concluded.
