How much weight do solar panels add to your roof?

By construction standards, the weight solar panels add to your roof usually isn't a cause for concern. The average residential PV panel measures about 1.65m by 1m. Including mounting equipment will add about 20kg to your roof. For a full 6kW array, you will need about 20 panels, adding about 365kg of dispersed weight.

Can a roof withstand a solar panel?

Before setting up rooftop solar panels for your home electricity generation needs, you should also ensure your roof can support the weight. The total weight-bearing capacity depends on the size and strength of your roof and the number of panels you need. Fortunately, most home roofs can comfortably withstand the weight of a solar panel array.

How many solar panels can be installed on a roof?

Your roof will need to be large enough to fit a suitable number of solar panels, as there's rarely much point putting just two or three panels up there. The average solar panel takes up 2m², and your installer should leave around 40cm on each side of the array, as well as 3cm between every panel.

How much does a solar panel weigh?

There are considerable weight differences depending on the exact brand and model of solar panel you buy, but on average they range from 16kg to 24kg. This means that they are certainly not always lightweight and it's often only safe to install them in pairs or by teams, hence why professional installation is always advised.

Are solar panels good for small roofs?

You can also opt for high-efficiency solar panels that have conversion rates as high as 23% (compared to the industry average of 18%).
