How do I install solar panels on a flat roof?

There are a few crucial steps to follow when installing solar panels on a flat roof: To start the process, an engineer will carry out a structural survey to check if your roof is suitable for handling the solar panels' weight and the ballast used to secure them.

Can solar panels be mounted on a flat roof?

For solar panels on a flat roof, mounting systems are slightly different and can include a triangle 'ballast' box to support the panels. For solar thermal panels (with cells that use the sun's heat to warm water in a house) things are a little different.

How far apart should solar panels be on a flat roof?

However, as a general rule of thumb, you need about one metrebetween each row of solar panels on a flat roof. Building and safety regulations also require a minimum distance of 0.5-1m between the solar panels and the edge of the roof. Where is the best place to put solar panels on a roof?

What angle should solar panels be installed on a flat roof?

The ideal pitch for a Solar Panel is around 30 degreesoff the horizontal. Simply because this allows the panels to gain more exposure from the sun throughout the entire day. When installing Solar panels on a flat roof, this is easily achieved. As the Solar Panels are installed onto a bracket which tilts the panel to around 30 degrees.

Do you need planning permission to install flat roof solar panels?

You usually need planning permission install flat roof solar panels. Solar panels on pitched or tilted house roofs rarely require planning permission because they fall under the 'permitted development' category - but that's not the case with flat roof solar panels.
