How many solar power projects are there in Zimbabwe?

As of 31 July 2019, the Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority (ZERA) had issued more than 77 power generation licences with 42 being solar power projects. A number of IPPs are already selling electricity to the Zimbabwe Electricity Transmission and Distribution Company (ZETDC) and feeding into the national grid.

How much does a solar IPP project cost in Zimbabwe?

Zimbabwe has announced a government implementation agreement (GIA) to expedite the commissioning of 27 solar IPP installations. The 1 GW of projects range from 5 MW arrays to 100 MW solar parks and will cost about \$1 billion in total. The government has promised to help make the IPP projects bankable.

Could solar power be cheaper in Zimbabwe?

Zimbabwe has enough solar power to support these. These solar systems could be made cheaper through the introduction of subsidies and tax incentives. Even better, the government could waive taxes on all certified systems coming into the country. And more needs to be done to publicise the use of gas in urban and rural households.
