Is it legal to install solar panels?

It is legal to install your solar panels; however, you must adhere to all building and electrical regulations, which might necessitate professional certification and can affect eligibility for incentive schemes. What happened to the Feed-in Tariff (FIT) scheme?

Can I use my solar panels if I'm not at home?

Additionally, even though your solar panels will generate electricity, it is unlikely to all be used by yourself. The sun is obviously only out during the day, so if you are not at home, it will be fed into the grid so that it can be used by somebody else.

Can solar energy provide a home with all the power?

In theory, solar energy should be able to provide your home with all the power it needs for the entire year, however, solar has a few limitations you should be aware of. Firstly, the solar panels should have maximum exposure to the sun year round, otherwise they'll struggle to generate adequate amounts of energy.

Can I use solar electricity without a battery?

Note that without an accompanying battery you can only use solar electricity as it's being generated. When you want to use it might not match with when your solar panels are generating. For example, your panels won't be producing power when it's dark and you want to switch on the lights or other appliances on a dark winter evening.
