The energy sector is central to Morocco's climate change strategy, especially its mitigation efforts. Morocco's updated NDC commits the country to reducing its greenhouse gas emissions by 18.3% by 2030 compared with the business-as-usual (BAU) scenario. In the energy efficiency rankings, Morocco was around 30 th between 1995 and 2000 and then lost about 10 ranks due to the acceleration of the domestic component of rural electrification. However, the increase in revenue generated by the grid extension has made up for the loss of energy efficiency due to domestic consumption since 2006.
