



National Compensation for Solar Photovoltaic Panels

Can I claim compensation for mis-sold solar panels?

If you feel you were mis-sold solar panels for your home you could claim compensation. Back in 2019, it was reported that the Financial Ombudsman Service had around 2000 complaints from unhappy customers who felt they had been mis-sold their solar panels, with more coming in every week.

Who is eligible for solar PV panels?

To be eligible for solar PV panels, your home needs to meet these specific requirements: Have an income of less than £31,000. Currently have an inefficient heating system within the D-G energy efficiency band. Own your home and live in it, or live in private rented accommodation (requires permission from the landlord).

Do solar panels pay for themselves?

The solar panels were originally sold as an investment, with customers being advised that the panels would pay for themselves because the financial benefits received from a Feed In Tariff (FIT) and energy bill reduction would cover the monthly finance repayments.

Are there government grants for solar panels in the UK?

There are several government grants for solar panels in the UK, promoting the use of renewable energy sources and helping decrease carbon emissions. The EU's Renewable Energy Directive set out for all member countries to reach a 32% renewables target before 2030.

Will new solar homes get a payment from suppliers?
