What is a Nauru power expansion plan?

The electrical network comprises 11kV, 3.3KV and LV overhead lines. Asian Development Bank (ADB) provided Government of Nauru (GoN) a transactional technical assistance TRTA to prepare a Nauru power expansion plan. The plan identified that a PV array and battery energy storage system should be constructed.

Who will implement solar project in Nauru?

The executing agency will be the Department of Finance and Sustainable Development. The implementing agency for solar component of project will be the Nauru Utilities Corporation (NUC). NUC will establish a project management unit within their existing organisational structure to implement the project.

Is Nauru Utilities Corporation a good company?

In particular, Nauru Utilities Corporation has a well-functioning procurement unit. They have participated in ADB funded Tenders for Power Generation Units, and regularly invite goods and works bids through Tenderlink.

How will ADB support the Nauru solar power development project?

ADB also provided GoN support to prepare a Feasibility Study for the recommended Nauru Solar Power Development Project which will comprise of a 6 megawatt PV plant coupled with a 5 megawatt /2.5 megawatt-hour battery energy storage system coupled with a SCADA installation.

How will Nauru's solar power system work?

The system will be fully integrated and automated with the existing diesel generation (17.9 MW installed capacity currently manually operated) to optimize solar energy use, to enable optimal BESS charging/discharging and to provide optimal shut off of the diesel engines. This will reduce Nauru's over reliance on diesel for power generation.

Nauru's grid electricity supply comes from a single power station operated by NUC. The generation, transmission and distribution equipment is old, with much of it urgently needing repair or outright replacement. The existing diesel engines have enough capacity to meet demand but if any one engine breaks down, load shedding is necessary.

SMARTEN is a 4-year project funded by GEF to enable the increased applications of renewable energy (RE) and energy efficiency (EE) technologies for supporting development in Nauru in accordance with the country's energy roadmap targets. This project is expected to reduce 1.049 Mil Metric Tons of CO₂ over its lifetime. What are SMARTEN's goals?

1.15mwp pv grid connect system A 1.15MWp PV generation system is installed at the old "Canstruct" site on the south end of Nauru and connected to the NUC 11kV local distribution network. The system, designed and installed by Clay ...

The Asian Development Bank grant, announced last week, will support the construction of a 6MW grid-connected solar power plant and a 5MW/2.5MWh battery storage system that will be integrated with existing diesel generation. From 3% To 47% Renewables. The impact the project will have is significant.

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The Nauru Solar Power Development Project - Battery Energy Storage System is being developed by Nauru Utilities. The project is owned by Nauru Utilities (100%). The key applications of the project are renewable energy integration and grid support services.

The Nauru Smart Grid Project is assisted by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and is a joint general contract of China Harbor-Huazi Technology-Rising Sun. It includes 6.9MW photovoltaic, 5MW/2.5MWh battery energy storage system, 5 diesel generators and one 11kV switch station.

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
