How does a solar panel installation work?

The installers start by setting up mounts, ensuring that the solar panel remains securely fastened to the roof and protects it from potential damage in bad weather. This is done by lifting some roof tiles in order to fix anchor points to the rafters. To these roof anchor points are attached the solar panel mounting system.

Do you need a solar panel system to be energy independent?

As long as you install a solar panel system powerful enough to cover your household's energy usage, you can rely on solar electricity for all your energy needs.

If you reside in an area that receives 5 hours of maximum sunlight and your solar panel has a rating of 200 watts, the output of your solar panel can be calculated as follows: Daily watt hours = 5 × 200 = 1000 watt hours. 1000 watt hours ÷ 1000 = 1 kWh.
