What is pm solar panel Yojana?

As mentioned above, technically, there is no scheme namely "PM Solar Panel Yojana". This name is used to refer to the schemes that are launched by Prime Minister and have the "Solar" component. The examples are - PM KUSUM Scheme, Solar Pump Schemes etc.

What is 'rooftop solar scheme' & 'pm Surya Ghar muft Bijli Yojan'?

The Finance Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman, announced the launch of the 'Rooftop Solar Scheme' or the 'PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana' in the Interim Budget 2024-25. In the full Budget 2024-25, the Finance Minister reiterated that this scheme will enable 1 crore households to obtain free electricity up to 300 units every month.

How to join Pradhan Mantri solar panel Yojana?

To be a part of Pradhan Mantri Solar Panel Yojana (aka Suryoday yojana) first ensure you fulfil the eligibility conditions. Then, follow the given steps to complete the registration process: Head to the Suryoday Solar Panel Scheme Portal. The first step is to create an user account.

What Yojana will be provided in budget 2024-25?

The Budget 2024-25 emphasised this yojana and provided that the government will provide for the installment of solar panels to 1 crore households. It will provide subsidies for installing rooftop solar panels for residential houses and using solar energy for electricity, which will help save money on electricity bills.

How does pm Surya Ghar muft Bijlee Yojana work?

The scheme provides for a subsidy of 60% of the solar unit cost for systems up to 2kW capacity and 40 percent of additional system cost for systems between 2 to 3kW capacity. The subsidy has been capped at 3kW capacity.
