

Proportion of solar power generation materials

What is the contribution of solar energy to global electricity production?

While the contribution of solar energy to global electricity production remains generally low at 3.6%, it has firmly established itself among other renewable energy technologies, comprising nearly 31% of the total installed renewable energy capacity in 2022 (IRENA, 2023).

How many articles on solar power generation materials were published between 2003 & 2023?

This study employs Web of Science and Citespace to visually analyze 521 articles on solar power generation materials published between 2003 and 2023. The development of these materials is categorized into three distinct phases: the start-up phase, rapid growth phase, and steady phase.

What percentage of global electricity production is renewable?

In 2016, as depicted in Fig. 1, renewables contributed to about 30% of the global installed capacity, providing nearly a quarter of global electricity production. The solar power (PV+CSP) accounted for nearly 8% of the renewable electricity production.

Is solar energy a future energy resource?

The utilization of renewable energy as a future energy resource is drawing significant attention worldwide. The contribution of solar energy (including concentrating solar power (CSP) and solar photovoltaic (PV) power) to global electricity production, as one form of renewable energy sources, is generally still low, at 3.6%.

How much solar energy will be generated in 2030?

Reaching an annual solar PV generation level of approximately 8300 TWh in 2030, in alignment with the Net Zero Scenario, up from the current 1300 TWh, will require annual average generation growth of around 26% during 2023-2030.

Are there gaps in solar energy?

The literature survey reveals that clear gaps still exist in the field of solar energy. In the next three decades, the solar PV field can advance to become the second prominent generation source by constructing more solar farms, allowing countries to generate approximately 25% of the world's total electricity needs by 2050.
