Can solar panels be installed on rafters or trusses?

How do you install a solar PV system on a roof?

Roof anchors have staggered fixing so work must be done (widen or fit noggins) before installing PV onto such narrow timbers. On-roof is the most common type of way when retro-fitting a solar pv system to your home, and there are many different manufactures of mounting systems but thankfully the correct way of installing them is the same.

Can solar PV systems be installed on a pitched roof?

The guidelines also say that provision must be made for ventilation behind the solar PV modules to provide cooling. With the introduction of MCS012 in March 2012 we would now expect all MCS certified installers of solar PV systems to install solar PV systems on pitched roofs using only MCS012 certified roof fixings.

What factors should you consider when installing roof-mounted solar panels?

One of the most important factors when installing roof-mounted solar panels is the condition and structure of the roof. It's vital that a roof be able to not only hold up the weight of the solar panels, but also withstand any wind loads that could pull on the roofing.
