Ziyad Ali Fadel, chaired a technical meeting with Chinese company Huawei to discuss the proposal for a fast-installation solar power plant with a capacity of 100 MW in Karbala.. The project is intended to be completed within six months and operational by summer 2025 to help meet peak electricity demand.

Last week, Iraq"s minister of electricity Adel Karim said that a 750-MW solar park would be set up in the southern Al-Muthanna Governorate to ensure enough power supply in the province. Another 150-MW solar initiative is planned in the country"s largest province by area, Al-Anbar Governorate.
