What is solar photovoltaic (PV) power generation?

Solar photovoltaic (PV) power generation is the process of converting energy from the sun into electricity using solar panels. Solar panels, also called PV panels, are combined into arrays in a PV system. PV systems can also be installed in grid-connected or off-grid (stand-alone) configurations.

How much energy does a solar PV system generate a year?

The installed solar PV generating capacity in September 2015 was 8.185 GWp. Based on a UK average yield of 960 kWh/kWp (2014), this capacity should generate in a typical year around 7860 GWh of electricity, or 2.6% of the UK's 303 TWh consumption in 2014.

How does solar power work?

The solar electricity seeks to convert light from the sun directly into electricity through a process known as photovoltaic. Photovoltaic system may be categorized as stand-alone photovoltaic system, photovoltaic system for vehicle applications (solar vehicles), grid-connected photovoltaic system and building systems.
