The Palestinian territory has a high potential for solar power generation, as it receives around 3,000 hours of sunshine per year. How many homes in Palestine use solar energy heaters?

Over half of all households in Palestine utilise solar energy heaters, although only 3% of houses depend on it as their main source. A 710kw photovoltaic plant was commissioned in September, 2014 in the vicinity of Jericho; it is the largest plant in Palestine to date.

Can solar power power a Palestinian enclave?

So, in recent years, people across the Palestinian enclave have been turning to solar energy to power their businesses and homes. Yasser al-Hajj, who owns a seaside fish farm and restaurant, installed solar panels six years ago. "Electricity is the backbone of the project.

Is Palestine a good place to invest in solar energy?

Palestine has some of the highest rate of solar water heating in the region, and there are a number of solar power projects. Table 1: Sources of Electricity in Palestine Based on Yearly Consumption (PCBS 2019). The West Bank is mainly supplied by three 161/33 kV substations: one in the south close to Hebron; another one in the central West Bank, near the town of Salfet, close to Nablus; and a third in the northern part of Jerusalem.

Can Palestinians achieve 10 percent of electricity production from renewable sources?

The Palestinian Energy Authority issued a renewable energy strategy in 2012 that aims to gradually achieve 10 percent of electricity production from renewable sources by the end of 2020. According to the strategy, this goal can be achieved if certain prerequisites are attained.
