What is MOSJ - environmental monitoring of Svalbard & Jan Mayen?

MOSJ (Environmental Monitoring of Svalbard and Jan Mayen) is an environmental monitoring system and part of the Government's environmental monitoring in Norway. An important function is to provide a basis for seeing whether the political targets set for the development of the environment in the North are being attained.

What is the difference between Svalbard and Jan Mayen?

Svalbard is an archipelago in the Arctic Ocean under the sovereignty of Norway, but is subject to the special status granted by the Svalbard Treaty. Jan Mayen is a remote island in the Arctic Ocean; it has no permanent population and is administered by the County Governor of Nordland.

Where are Svalbard and Jan Mayen located?

The islands are located north and northwest of Norway, within the southern limits of Arctic sea ice -- the northernmost point of Svalbard is within a 620 mi (1,000 km) of the North Pole. Svalbard is approximately 24,570 square mi (63,000 square km); Jan Mayen is approximately 145 square mi (373 square km).

How many people in Svalbard and Jan Mayen are offline?

At the start of 2022, 37.0 percent of the population in Svalbard and Jan Mayen, or 944 people, did not use the internet.

How many people use the Internet in Svalbard and Jan Mayen?

According to Kepios analysis, 37.0 percent of the population in Svalbard and Jan Mayen, or 944 people, did not use the Internet at the beginning of 2022. This means that approximately the remaining 63.0 percent, or 1,338 people, used the Internet.

What is Svalbard & Jan Mayen in ISO 3166-2?

ISO 3166-2:SJ is the entry for Svalbard and Jan Mayen in ISO 3166-2, a system for assigning codes to subnational administrative divisions. However, further subdivision for Svalbard and Jan Mayen occurs under Norway's entry, ISO 3166-2:NO:

Temperatures typically range between -14 °C (7 °F) and 6 °C (43 °F) through the year, but rarely can drop to -30 °C (-22 °F) or can rise to as high as 16 °C (61 °F).The average annual precipitation amounts to about 538 mm (21.2 inches) and receives 126 rainy days on the 1 mm (0.04 inches) threshold annually.Longyearbyen enjoys an average of 2468 hours of sunshine ...

The flora of these islands in the European sector of the Arctic does not differ greatly from the general aspect of the flora of Greenland in the west, Franz Josef Land and Novaya Zemlya in the east, or Kola and northernmost Norway in the south. This especially concerns Bear Island and Jan Mayen, both of which are inhabited by a meager flora.

The weather around Jan Mayen is often not so good: it is said the weather is foul for 362 days of the year. There may be heavy rain, wind and fog but then, soon after, the sun may break through and the air becomes clear. In June, when our ships visit Jan Mayen, the average temperature is around 2º to 3ºC (36º to 37ºF).
