Why did Italy ban solar panels on agricultural land?

The Italian government has banned solar PV installations on agricultural land, in a move that the nation's solar trade association said would cost Italy EUR60 billion (US\$64.5 billion). The government rules constitute a complete ban on ground-mounted solar PV projects on land classed as agricultural.

Will photovoltaic systems be banned in Italy?

According to Italy's minister of agriculture, food sovereignty and forestry, Francesco Lollobrigida, the ban will focus on photovoltaic systems placed on the ground in areas classified as agricultural.

Will Italy ban ground-mounted solar PV projects on agricultural land?

The government rules constitute a complete ban on ground-mounted solar PV projects on land classed as agricultural. The policy is intended to preserve Italy's productive agricultural land and "put an end to the wild installation of ground-mounted photovoltaics," according to agriculture minister Francesco Lollobrigida.

Will agrivoltaic projects be banned?

However, the decree will not prevent agrivoltaic projects where solar panels are installed above fields of crops without interfering with productivity. Solar plants on non-productive agricultural land such as quarries and solar facilities financed under the recovery and resilience plan framework will also be exempt from the ban. Have you read?

Is agrivoltaic project exempt from the EU solar ban?

The ban covers photovoltaic systems placed on the ground in areas classified as agricultural, but does not refer to agrivoltaic projects, where solar panels are installed above fields of crops, Lollobrigida said. Projects benefitting from EU funds, such as energy communities, are exempt.
