How much does a solar PV system cost?

The average cost of a typical 3.5kW solar PV system is currently around €6,000, roughly 10% of which pays for professional installation. To save cash, you may be tempted to buy a DIY solar panel kit and fit your panels by yourself.

Where should solar panels be placed?

The most important piece of your solar panel system will be the solar array itself. You want your solar panels placed in a sunny spot on your property. The panels should face south for optimal energy production, but they can also face east or west and still produce a good amount of electricity, so long as the area is clear of shade.

How do I register a solar PV system?

If you're planning to install a solar PV system in your home, you must register it with your Distribution Network Operator (DNO). The DNO is the company responsible for bringing electricity to your home. Usually, your installer will register the device for you.

How to install solar panels?

The basic system is to start with the installation of a rack or platform. If the panels are roof-mounted, a roof racking system is first installed. A ground platform is needed if the panels are ground-mounted, and installing the solar panels is not difficult. What is more difficult is wiring them.

Do I need a DNO to install a solar PV system?

If you live in a listed building, conservation area or national park, there may be additional restrictions. If you're planning to install a solar PV system in your home, you must register it with your Distribution Network Operator (DNO). The DNO is the company responsible for bringing electricity to your home.
