

# Zimbabwe power plant solar energy

### What is the largest solar plant in Zimbabwe?

The largest solar plant under construction in the country is a 25 MWfacility in Matabeleland North province. The Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority (ZERA) reported this week that seven solar PV projects with a combined capacity of 66.6 MW are now in advanced stages of construction and are expected to be grid-connected by end of this year.

How many solar projects are there in Zimbabwe?

The sixoperational solar projects are delivering 7.47MW into the grid. The interest in investing in solar projects in Zimbabwe comes at a time when rolling power cuts have become the order of the day due to obsolete equipment at thermal power plants and low water levels at the Kariba Dam. ### How much solar power does Zimbabwe have?

Zimbabwe had around 17 MWof installed PV capacity at the end of 2020,according to the latest statistics from the International Renewable Energy Agency. The country's grid has suffered from daily power outages over the past decade, with the government struggling to raise capital to invest in new power stations.
